Synopsis <i>Internet Pornography (for males)</i> <i>Pornography is not new but the Internet has made it easily available even for children. People can now have easy access to it without having to leave their homes or even paying for it. The effects of Pornography addiction are very serious. As such, we must educate our children on awareness of such effects and teach them how they can avoid and handle challenges specific to Internet Pornography.</i> <i>Cyber Relationships (for females)</i> <i>Increased interaction on the Internet through social media platforms also increases the dangers related to Cyber Contacts (people you meet online). However, the Internet affords anonymity and people you meet online can hide their identity if they wish to. Therefore, it is important to educate our students to be discerning when sharing personal information and understand the dangers related to meeting their cyber contacts.</i>
