### Health and Safety

- You are reminded *not to send your child/ward to school if they are unwell or have flu-like symptoms*. Please bring them to consult a doctor instead, and update your child's Character Coaches with the relevant MC. Let's continue to practise good personal hygiene and exercise social responsibility at all times, including your child having a working thermometer with her/him.
- There will be a semestral temperature-taking exercise on 1 April. We would appreciate your help in ensuring that your child has a working thermometer on hand every day.
- You may drive your child to school in the morning but please be reminded to drive slowly and exercise caution around and within the school campus.





### Attire/Grooming

6. Students must be properly attired for lessons in class and during Physical Education (P.E) lessons. We seek your support in ensuring that your child/ward observes the school rules and regulations. Kindly refer to the 2026 e-Student Handbook (*Section 3, pages 23-25*) which is available on our school website at <http://broadricksec.moe.edu.sg/>, for detailed information. Attire checks will be conducted in Week 1 and Week 5. Students who do not comply may not be allowed to attend school until the issue has been rectified.

### Limited Handphone Usage Policy

7. Students are not permitted to use mobile phones during curriculum hours (7.30 am to 5 pm) within the school premises. Students are required to store their phones in their lockers during this time. Phones found in students' possession will be confiscated for the day. Repeated violations will result in the phone being returned only to the student's parents or guardians.

### Change to Daily Routines – Reporting and Dismissal Times from Term 2

8. As shared in the PG letter dated 12 March 2026, the school has made changes to the reporting and dismissal times from term 2. After observing our students over the course of Term 1, we are encouraged to see that many are ready to practise greater self-directedness in managing their learning, particularly during FLEX Time. These changes aim to further support our students in developing greater independence and responsibility in their learning. The standard reporting time for all students will be 8.00 am, instead of the current 7.30 am. The only exception is Thursday (Assembly Day), when students are still required to report to school at 7.30 am. Students with timetabled lessons at 7.30 am, will continue to report at that time. You may continue to send your child/ward to school earlier if necessary. Students who arrive before the reporting time may proceed to the canteen or other designated areas within the school compound for self-study.

9. The standard dismissal time for all students will be 1.50 pm, instead of the current 2.30 pm. The earlier dismissal allows students to have lunch earlier and better prepare for their CCA, remedial or enrichment programmes, and Student-Initiated Learning (SIL). Students with timetabled lessons after 1.50 pm will remain in school until the completion of their lessons. Students involved in remedial, enrichment, or CCA activities may be required to remain in school later, typically until 6.00 pm on CCA days.

10. We seek your partnership in nurturing self-directed learners. We encourage you to continue working hand in hand with the school to support your child/ward in developing good routines, discipline, and ownership of their learning.

Student Initiated Learning (SIL) for Active Lifestyle

16.
